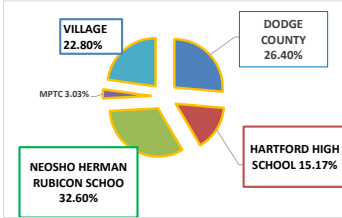

**Tax bill payments can be mailed to: Village of Neosho Treasurer, PO Box 178, Neosho WI 53059-0178. The Village has a drop box in front of the Village Hall Door for payments. A receipt will be mailed back to you for your records. Dog Licenses are taken care of at the Village Hall. Dog Licenses are required per state statute. Dog Licenses are \$10 for altered dogs and \$10 for non-altered dogs. Dog licenses expire December 31. If not licensed by March 31st there is a \$5 late fee. If paying for dog license with taxes the rabies certificate will be returned with your receipt and dog license. If you have an escrow check make sure all parties have signed the back of the check. Make checks out to the Village of Neosho.**

**Thank you to the Horicon Bank as they will once again be collecting taxes** for the Village of Neosho.  
Only exact amounts will be accepted (at least half or more, or up to the entire balance).
