The Village of Neosho is requesting proposals to inspect the dam in Neosho located on Hwy 67, as required by the Wisconsin Dept. of Natural Resources, over the next eleven years. The dam schedule is attached for review. The Village of Neosho Reserves the right to reject or accept any or all bids, or enter into negotiation with any bidder. Award of contract, if a contract is awarded, may be to the lowest or most advantageous bidder. Proposals must be submitted to the Village of Neosho, PO Box 178, Neosho WI 53059 or in the drop box located at Village Hall 210 North Schuyler Street, Neosho, no later than April 1, 2022. Proposals may also be submitted to neoshovillage@frontier.com; however, as with regular mail delivery, electronic mail is subject to electronic technicalities.

Bidder must use this form. Mark envelope "**Dam Inspection**".

- 1) All work must be completed by a professional engineer, licensed in the State of Wisconsin.
Description of work:
- 2) Consulting engineer shall review, recommend update Operation and Maintenance Plan and Emergency Action Plan.
- 3) Consulting engineer shall timely submit final dam inspection report to WDNR for approval.
- 4) Final dam inspection reports must be approved by WDNR professional for final payment.
- 5) Upon completion, all data will become property of the Village of Neosho.
- 6) All work is to be completed in a timely manner each year.
- 7) The consulting engineer shall obtain and maintain a general commercial liability insurance policy with a minimum combined single liability limit of \$1,000,000 and provide the County with a certificate of insurance evidencing the existence of the same. The consulting engineer shall obtain and maintain workers compensation insurance as required by Wisconsin Law.
- 8) Consulting engineer agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the county from all claims, damages, and expenses including attorney fees, arising out of the performance of the work described herein, which claim, damages and expenses are the result or attributable to the acts or omission in whole, or in part of the consulting engineer his employees, or invitees.
- 11) Work performed by consulting engineer which exceeds the scope of normal inspection will be negotiated and agreed on by the parties before additional work is completed.
