- Call to Order/ Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

- Discussion, coordination, and possible action related to the Neosho Millpond dam drawdown and related events. Possible updates with possible action of stop logs and dam inspection, and dam maintenance, repairs, fundraising and dam failure analysis.
- Discussion with possible action of related dam expenses such as the crane expense, expense related to the construction of and placement of stop logs.
- Discussion with possible action of timing of events.

August 1st, the Neosho Mill Pond will begin a process of drawdown to allow for the inspection of and operation of the dam gate function, and further inspection of

the concrete aggregate. This is a required inspection by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. The Village will have an engineer present. The inspection is scheduled to take place during the week that follows.

If the gate fails, the Village will be required to repair or replace the gate. Stop logs have been purchased in advance.

Adjournment.
